The challenge is being curated by Phyllis Manley, a member of NACQI who lives in Pennsylvania. Phyllis is inviting about 5 – 6 quilt guilds to participate in this challenge.

Liz Dragone will assist Phyllis and she will be our ESQ guild's coordinator

The Light Challenge

Light – the natural agent that stimulates sight and makes things visible
...illumination...ignite...brightness...bright...sunny

Shining...luminescence... Make something start burning... a source of light... not heavy.

Here are the basics of the challenge:

Commit to participate by June 1, 2022 by sending an email to Liz Dragone at joelizbcsc@aol.com

Make a **24 inch x 24 inch quilt**, expressing “**Light**”. Any interpretation of light!

Any technique, any style, as long as the quilt can pack flat.

Turn in your quilt and registration form to your guild coordinator (Liz Dragone) at the September ESQ guild meeting (**September 1, 2022**) or contact Liz to send her your quilt. Liz has volunteered to gather the ESQ quilts together and send them to Phyllis Manley, the challenge curator.

The quilts will become part of a traveling show which will move from one participating guild to another, beginning in January 2023. Your quilt will travel to each guild where members answered the challenge, before being returned to the maker/home guild, via your guild coordinator (Liz).

A Viewer's Choice format will determine awards of First, Second and Third place, each with a cash prize.
